

Move-Ups after entries close must be submitted, in writing, to the Trial secretary by 6:00 pm

Monday, May 25, 2015, Dog's registered name & call name, breed, AKC reg. #, title completed and date, class currently entered, new class requested, owner's name and date. E-mail move-ups will only be official after e-mail confirmation of move-up is sent.

Move-ups for the trial will be allowed provided the above information is given to the secretary before the close of each dav's trial.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be moved up to another class after entries close. (Except for move-up provisions as specified above) Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Entries which are incorrect, illegible, or incomplete will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor. Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.
