CORONAVIRUS INFO

We are trying to make the best show possible given the current COVID situation. As of 8/10, the state of WA is allowing shows like ours with mandatory restrictions. All participants will be required to adhere to these main items (more details pg 2)

Cloth Masks mandatory indoors at all times – even when running.

Masks required outdoors when not socially distant.

No Crating allowed indoors

No spectators, visitors, family, friends allowed – only participants and crew

Only allowed indoors while running or walking course

Dedicated “flow” of people thru building. Dedicated entrance/exit doors.

A COVID waiver will be required when you arrive (for club, crew, facility)

A set of COVID questions and possibly a temp check will be done each morning

If you feel that you cannot adhere to these restrictions, are sick, have been exposed to COVID-19, or have other reasons not to be around crowds – please stay home!

Evergreen Belgian Tervuren Club Agility Trial 2021 COVID-19 Information

We are working to be compliant with AKC, CDC, State and County Health guidelines. All guidelines may change as we get closer to the event time.

Masks – Cloth masks are required in all indoor areas in WA state. That includes while running your dog. This is a state mandate and one we are required to follow. The exits from the building are close to the rings and we will try to provide an outside the doors for you to remove your masks.

Food - The club will not be offering any food. We will be offering water from bottles, but you will be given them from someone with PPE. There will be no evening potlucks and unfortunately, no MACH/PACH cakes. Please plan accordingly.

Crating - There will be no crating in the stalls. We are required to minimize the number of people in the building and insure those that are in the building are distanced. Crating out of your vehicle will be encouraged. You are also welcomed to bring shade tents and there will be a designated location (to be determined). Parking spots close to the entrance and exit doors will be reserved for those crating from vehicles. The “in” doors and “out” doors will be clearly marked and left open. Please honor those door signs.

Washing, disinfectants, PPE – Hand washing is critical. We are working to expand those facilities. Hand sanitizer and other limited PPE will be available from the club, but please plan on bring your own.

Bathrooms - Disinfecting spray will be in the porta-potties and restrooms for seats and door handles. It will be your responsibility to sanitize upon entering and leaving these locations.

Trial Specific Modifications:

Gate Check-in/Steward - One person will be doing check-in and will receive worker coupons. Class run order copies will be made for handlers by class, so people do not have to keep looking at the board. Daily run orders will also be posted in many locations. This will force us to limit moving of dogs after running order is printed and posted. This may mean that it may be necessary that we wait for people with multiple dogs.

Briefings by Judge and Trial Chair – We will have limited briefings. We must have very few people in the building at any given time. We will do our best to communicate (postings, website, texting, etc.) so please bear with us.

Handlers waiting for their turn – Please keep 6 feet between handlers/dogs while waiting to go into the ring. Then, they will proceed to the entry gate as instructed by the Gate Steward. **Handlers must wear masks whenever in the ring – including while running.**

Walk-Throughs - Walk-throughs will be managed by number of handlers in a height class and the estimate shown in the charts on the running order. We must keep each ring to less than about 20 people at a time, so there may be many walkthroughs.

Workers - Masks and gloves should be worn for all positions while in the ring.

The Chief Ring Steward and/or Trial Chair will have the white boards set up next to the entrance doors.

The scoring table, leash runner, and bar setters should disinfect the chairs upon completion of their class. You are welcome to disinfect before as well. There will be disinfectant at the scorer’s table. The timer will be located at a different location than the scorer.

Results/Stickers/Ribbons - Results will be posted on wall boards by class instead of in the binders. Stickers will be printed and pre-cut so you will only pick up your own. Ribbons will be laid out on the table. The results and ribbons MAY be on a table outside near the trial secretary area. Only take your own.

Waivers and COVID check in:

Waiver – The EBTC, R2Agility, and Fun Fur Paws, their owners, operators, members, and volunteers are working very hard to make this event the most compliant event possible. However, activities like dog shows are potentially dangerous given the current COVID pandemic. A specific waiver will need to be signed holding the above entities harmless in the event somebody gets sick at the event. This is in addition to the waiver on the AKC entry form.

COVID Check in – To help meet the WA state guidelines for this event, each participant will need to answer a brief set of questions and potentially have a non-contact temperature check. Are you feeling sick now? Have you been exposed to COVID recently? Have you received a positive COVID test in the last 14 days?

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020 and fully approved as of 1/1/2021

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

ENTRY FEES

\$19.00 for the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd runs and \$12.00 for the 4th, 5th, and 6th runs of each dog per day. These include the required AKC fees of \$3.50 1st run and \$3.00 each additional run.

Junior Handlers are \$9 per run. The dog MUST be handled by the Junior, who MUST have an AKC Junior Handler number.

Catalog \$10.00. Please pre-order using entry form. A limited number will be available at the trial.

The EBTC is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online entries: 220 Paper entries 440. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

MAIL paper entry forms and check to: Robin Cohen, 16820 226th Ave NE, Woodinville, WA 98077. Please make checks payable to "EBTC". Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must: 1) Include postage or be metered; 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender. 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required."

REFUNDS

A refund (less \$5 per run) of the entry amount will be given for any bitch that comes into season after entries close, provided that written notification is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first class. No other refunds will be given after closing.

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday Feb 22, 2021**. Include the dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day moves-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the AKC or have AKC Limited Registration, PAL/ILP, an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Approved FSS breeds are also eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

The following lists the required jump height for preferred and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judges only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial that do not possess an official height card.

Dogs of all levels are allowed to enter the premier classes!!

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION

Please indicate if your dog needs to be measured on the entry form. You do NOT need to send in a copy with your entry. If the measurement of your dog at the trial puts your dog into a different jump height than entered, you must notify the Trial Secretary **immediately!**

OBSTACLES

Obstacles shall meet the specifications outlined in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials. **All Days there will be NO Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for qualifying scores and for 1st through 4th place in each height division in each class. A qualifying score is required for all awards.

≈ Qualifying: Dark Green ≈ First Place: Blue ≈ Second Place: Red ≈ Third Place: Yellow ≈ Fourth Place: White

New title ribbons will be given for any dog completing a title at this trial!

A MACH, PACH, OR PAX rosette will be awarded for any new MACH/PACH/PAX AT these trials. Please let us know if you are close!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Check your entry forms and confirmations!

Please be aware that AKC rules prohibit modification of an entry after the closing date/time. The ONLY allow changes are for "move-ups" in class and those are required in writing by 6PM of the Monday before the trial. The trial secretary is not allowed to change jump heights, preferred vs. regular, or move down in classes after closing.

A preliminary email confirmation will be sent when the entry is received and processed. Please check those confirmations closely and notify the trial secretary if you have corrections or changes before the closing date.

Final entry confirmations and approximate check-in times will be sent to the address or email address on the Official AKC entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. We will NOT wait for exhibitors, except for pre-arranged changes due to conflict.

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, or telegraph entry forms cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement attached are not acceptable.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

The Evergreen Belgian Tervuren Club, Fun Fur Paws, and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardian.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs(s) and/or child(ren) create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area and off leash areas.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Crating Information: Crating space in the arena is limited. There is crating in the stalls in the arena. You will be expected to share stalls with other exhibitors and their dogs. Stall doors must be left open.

Food Information: There are fast food locations and grocery stores in Mount Vernon within 10 miles of the show site. Worker food and snacks are planned for the show as well.

Set-Up: The arena will not be available for setting up until Friday morning.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
