Online Entry

This trial does accept online entries through **R2Agility** (<https://r2agilityonline.com>). During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries 120; Paper entries 230. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Refunds

A full refund of entry fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season, and a refund of entry fees, less \$5.00 per run, will be given for any dog or handler that is injured or ill, if written notification is provided to the Trial Secretary 30 minutes prior to the beginning of judging for the day.

Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds.

Catalogs

Electronic marked catalogs will be available upon request at the conclusion of the trial. Please email the trial secretary to request a catalog.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC limited registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners are eligible to participate, provided that their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Please designate the dog's breed as "All American Dog" on the entry form.

Important Information for Exhibitors -- PLEASE READ!

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, fax, email or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form, are not acceptable. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after closing, EXCEPT as provided for in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 21. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es). Contact the Trial Secretary if you have questions.

Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the delivery signature requirement waived, otherwise receipt may be delayed. Entries will not be considered as being received until they are delivered to the address given on the

entry form. Please note the opening date of Aug 31, 2026; no entries will be accepted before that date. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in one envelope; envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be considered invalid and will be returned to the sender. No hand delivered entries can be accepted until 8:00a Aug 31, 2026.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent (other than as specified on page 2), disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be emailed (or sent by postal mail to the address on the official AKC entry form, if no email is provided) after the closing date; if not received at least 7 days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a valid email address on the entry form, or includes a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Spokane Agility Club, Twin Willows, and trial secretary assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site and no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entering Regular & Preferred Jump Heights

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights [in different classes] within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. [EXAMPLE: if you are entering a dog in some Regular classes and some Preferred classes, submit one entry form for the Regular classes, and another entry form for the Preferred classes.] When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Measuring and Jump Height Card Information

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

On the entry form, please designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to Measured List. It

is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during the day of show check-in. However, it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.

Our judge is a Volunteer Measuring Official. Dogs under 2 years of age with an official temporary measurement, dogs with a permanent height card do not need to be measured. All other dogs MUST be measured by one of the judges prior to running; this measurement does count toward the dog's permanent height card.

Move Ups

Move-ups after entries close must be submitted in writing (email OK) so that the Trial Secretary receives them by 6:00PM PST on Monday Oct 12, 2026. Reply to your confirmation and include the class you are moving from/to. Email to cerealwithdogs@gmail.com. If you do not receive an acknowledgement of your move-up request, please contact the Trial Secretary to make sure that it was received. No phone or text message move ups accepted.

Day to Day move-ups will be accepted at the trial; they must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial is concluded each day.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying. FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show. Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed. Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed. The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge. Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Toys are allowed in the ring, food/treats are not allowed in the ring.

- Toys must be non-audible
- Toys may not leave the handler's hand
- Toys that roll freely cannot be used

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Volunteers

We will have a whiteboard available during the trial for volunteers to sign up. Please volunteer to work – even if you are only available to work for one height in a class, that will help the trials run more smoothly. You will get a \$2 coupon usable toward future SAC agility entries for each class that you work in.

Obstacles

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

It is very difficult and time consuming to clean agility equipment. So, unfortunately, due to increased issues with dogs eliminating on agility equipment, a \$25 fee will be imposed per occurrence.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular & Preferred Classes

First Place: Blue Third Place: Yellow
Second Place: Red Fourth Place: White
Qualifying Score: Dark Green
Masters QQ: Black & Foil Rosette

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

Masters QQ Ribbons are for dogs qualifying in Master Standard and Master Jumpers (preferred or regular) in the same day.

New Title Rosettes are available for dogs completing a new title at these trials.

All dogs completing a MACH/PACH/PAX at this trial will receive a MACH/PACH bar and ribbon. Please let us know before the trial if you are close.

Trial Location

These Agility Trials will be held indoors on packed dirt on a working horse farm. Ring size is 99' x 100'. Please be respectful of the surrounding livestock and outbuildings. Dogs should stay within the parking, camping, and trial area. The ring will be fenced, with entry/exit openings. Crating will be allowed indoors. Exhibitors can set up in the arena starting at 5:30 PM Thursday. The arena will be set up at 5:00 PM. If the arena layout is done earlier, the club will allow exhibitors to set up at an earlier time. The arena will be open to exhibitors at 7:00 AM Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The Trial Committee reserves the right to consolidate or move setups if necessary, to ensure crating space is available for all and access to the ring and practice jump is maintained.

Limit your space to 4x6 feet for one or two dogs, adding more space for more than three or more. Always supervise your dog and prevent lunging at other dogs. Please

avoid crating reactive dogs in busy walkways and bring covers for their crates as needed.

Dust Control: Twin Willows Farm indoor arena is a horse arena. We have been advised that Magnesium Chloride Hexahydrate has been used in the past, mixed in with the dirt to control dust. This is not the same strength that is used on roads to melt ice. Safety Data Sheet available upon request of trial secretary.

Be advised this is a working horse farm and livestock will be present. Please be courteous.

FOOD AT THE TRIAL: There will be no food provided for this trial. Fast food restaurants are in Deer Park.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds (and at your motel)!

WATER: NO potable water is available on site. Please be prepared by bringing your own for yourself and your dogs.

Turn left onto Wallbridge Rd and continue for approximately .5 miles to the trial site on the right."

Course Walk Through & Warm Up

Course maps will be posted, emailed and available online in Agility Gate after 12:00a (midnight) the day of the trial per AKC regulation.

Judge's briefing (except Masters) and course walk-throughs will occur prior to each class. Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Injured handlers may walk with their substitute handler. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

Walk throughs may be split if needed to have groups of less than 30 walking at one time.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving the dog. Use is limited to 3 minutes per dog/handler combination.

Camping/Parking/Lodging

Parking is \$10.00 per night. Prepayment is greatly appreciated. All overnight parking (including tents and autos) will be charged the same rate. No charge for day parking.

ALL PARKING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. The Spokane Agility Club and Twin Willows Farm assume NO responsibility for fire, theft, and/or damage to any vehicle or its cargo. The Agility Club reserves the right to withdraw the privilege of parking on the grounds from any person who feels that he or she cannot abide by the rules and instructions or who resorts to abusive language or other tactics.

HANDICAP PARKING – Handicap parking is to provide suitable surface to the rings, not necessarily close to the rings. Handicap parking space is VERY LIMITED. All handicap vehicles must have a handicap license plate. Please indicate on your parking form so we can reserve a space for you.

RULES AND REGULATIONS – Parking will be self-serve. The area will be designated with signs; if you have any questions, check with Maggie Mascari. If you have any special needs please indicate on your parking form so we can reserve a spot for you. Group parking is first come, first serve. The first person in your group may hold a few spots around them for those coming. When parking, please be respectful of the roadway space and your neighbors. Please bring exhaust diverters if you plan on running a generator.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
