ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

"MHDPC is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 220 runs Paper entries: 440 runs. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

1) include postage or be metered;

2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required"

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes First Place: Blue Second Place: Red Third Place: Yellow Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

A MACH Ribbon and MACH Bar will be given for any new MACH dog! Let us know if you are close.

All Breed High in Trial

Custom embroidered folding chairs will be given out for High in Trial for runs on Saturday only, which will be awarded Sunday morning in the general briefing. The highest combined score from two clean rounds, for all dogs entered in the show, for both small (8", 12" & 16") and large (20", 24" & 26") dogs in the regular classes will win. Scores of 100 in both classes is required to be in contention. Scoring is based on the highest combined YPS.

High Scoring Doberman

The highest scoring Doberman in the STD class and JWW class on Friday will be awarded a Laurelwood Doberman plate and a custom embroidered blanket for Saturday, which will be presented in the next morning's briefing. Scoring is based on the highest YPS for qualifying runs. An award will be given for high Doberman in STD and high Doberman in JWW.

High in Group

A Rosette will be offered to the highest scoring dog in each Group (including All-American) Friday and Saturday, which will be awarded during the next morning's Exc. Standard Class briefing. Scoring is based on highest combined YPS

High Junior on Saturday

A ribbon will be awarded to the highest scoring Junior Handler (highest score and YPS for Std and Jww)

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION	The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judges only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial who do not possess an official height card.

8 inches	for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	4" Preferred class

<u>OBSTACLES</u>: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. <u>*All Days*</u> there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

<u>CLASSES OFFERED</u>: See the chart above for offered classes per day. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the **American Kennel Club**, **8051 Arco Corporate Drive**, **Raleigh**, **NC 27617-3390**, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION: You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please indicate on the entry form if you have a height card (perm or temp), or need to be measured.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, without the agreement attached are not acceptable.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Mt. Hood Doberman Pinscher Club** assumes **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday, Feb. 1st, 2016.** Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to <u>r2agility@frontier.com</u>. No phone move ups accepted.

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

REFUNDS: 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a <u>written request is received by the trial secretary on or before</u> <u>the trial closing date</u>. After closing, refunds will be given, <u>if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to</u> <u>the start of the trial</u>, less all -\$8/run, for injured/ill handlers, or injured/ill dogs, or less \$5/run for bitches in season. MHDPC reserves the right to require certification of said injury or illness from a veterinarian or doctor prior to refund being issued. <u>No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial</u>. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not allowed in the Agility Trial area.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION

There is an abundance of crating space around the rings on all sides, on concrete. There is no heating in the building, and portable propane heaters are not allowed in the building.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
