### Entry Fees

First entry is \$23.00 per day; additional entries of same dog, same day are \$13.00. **Please make checks payable to SAA (Stride Ahead Agility).** Entry fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 first entry/\$3.00 additional entry. Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$10 on the entry form. A limited number will be available at the trial for \$15.

A full refund of entry fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season, and a refund of entry fees, less AKC fees and applicable judging fees, will be given for any dog that is injured or ill, **if written notification from a veterinarian is given to the Trial Secretary prior to the beginning of judging for the day.** Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds.

### ONLINE ENTRIES

Online entries are available for these trials through R2Agility's online entry service. Go to [www.r2agilityonline.com](http://www.r2agilityonline.com) to set up an account and follow instructions there.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be as follows: **For each trial, 100 runs/trial via online entries, 230 runs/trial via paper entries.** If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

**Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate, provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. \*\*Please designate the dog's breed as "All American" on the entry form.\*\***

## Important Information for Exhibitors -- PLEASE READ!

**Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, fax, e-mail or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form, are not acceptable. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.**

**A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class.** The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as a result of completing a title, and correction of specific errors as provided in the *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 21*) after the closing date of the trial. **Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es). Contact the Trial Secretary if you have questions!**

**Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the delivery signature requirement waived; otherwise receipt may be delayed. Entries will not be considered as being received until they are delivered to the address given on the entry form. Please note the opening date of April 1, 2016; no entries will be accepted before that date. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in one envelope; envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be considered invalid, and will be returned to the sender. No hand delivered entries can be accepted until 8:00 AM on April 2, 2016.**

**\*\*\*GSSSC is using a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time.** A maximum of 25 entries (runs) will be placed on each trial's wait list. All entries must have been received by the Trial Secretary prior to Wednesday, May 18, 2016 at 6:00 PM. Any entries withdrawn, with notification to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail OK) by **6:00 PM on Monday, May 30, 2016** will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry; otherwise no refund will be given for withdrawn entries, except as specified above. Any wait listed entry that does not get into the trial will receive a full refund.\*\*\*

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent (other than as specified on page 2), disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be e-mailed (or sent by postal mail to the address on the official AKC entry form, if no e-mail is provided) after the closing date; if not received at least 7 days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. **Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a valid e-mail address on the entry form, or includes a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry.**

Security personnel will be present at the trial site overnight. However, Greater Spokane Shetland Sheepdog Club. assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site and no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated warm-up area.

**THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.**

**Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

### Height Divisions

Regular	Preferred	
8"	4"	For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.
12"	8"	For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.
16"	12"	For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.
20"	16"	For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
24"	20"	For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.
26"	---	Dogs may be entered at this height at owner's discretion.

In the Regular classes, handlers may choose to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In the Preferred classes, dogs may NOT run in a higher height division than that determined by their withers height.

The entry form has a box at the top of the form to check if the dog needs to be measured. Please check this box if appropriate, so that the Trial Secretary knows to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in, but it is still the exhibitor's responsibility to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.  
**Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.**

**Jan Skurzynski is a VMO, so dogs under age 2 without a temporary measurement, and dogs age 2 or over without a height card or two official measurements must be measured before running.**

### NEW Classes – Premier Standard and Jumpers With Weaves

Once again we are offering the newest AKC Agility titling class, Premier. This class will provide an opportunity for agility competitors to demonstrate different handling skills than those required for the Master Level Classes in Standard and Jumpers With Weaves. The Premier class will focus on handling the sequence or sequences of the day.

Both Standard and JWW Premier courses will be Master level courses incorporating a number of elements that challenge the dog and handler in ways that are not seen on traditional AKC courses. These elements include sequences like threadles, back-side jumps, pull-throughs, layering, challenging weave pole entries, and longer running passes. One bi-directional jump or tunnel will be allowed to encourage handling strategies. Obstacle spacing on Premier courses may exceed the limits of those on Master courses.

Premier courses will use the same obstacles as the corresponding Master course. At the judge's discretion, a viaduct may be used in place of the panel jump, there may be 3 tunnel passes and there will be no table. A Premier course will have 19 to 21 obstacles, 3 side switches, 4 Premier Elements and 5 Challenges. Courses will be judged using AKC Master scoring and hand signals.

**Eligibility.** Dogs with an AX title are eligible to enter Premier Standard Regular. Dogs with an AX or AXP title are eligible to enter Premier Standard Preferred. Dogs with an AXJ title are eligible to enter Premier Jumpers with Weaves Regular. Dogs with an AXJ or AJP title are eligible to enter Premier Jumpers with Weaves Preferred.

### Move-Up and Class Change Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the handler, as a result of completing an agility title at an earlier event, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing (e-mail is acceptable), by 6:00 PM on **Monday, May 30, 2016**. If a dog finishes a title during the trial, the handler may move up for the following days by filling out a move-up form (available at the event) and turning it in to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the end of judging for the day.

The Regulations now allow exhibitors who have entered an incorrect class to change their entry to the class for which their dog is eligible, but the request for such a change must be in writing and must be submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the Trial.

### Judging

Judging starts 10:00 AM on Friday and 8:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday. Judge's briefing and course walk-through will take place prior to that time, as specified in entry confirmation.

On Friday and Sunday, jump height divisions will run Small to Tall. On Saturday, they will run Tall to Small. Classes will alternate between the two rings (Standard and JWW). The order of class levels will be: **first**, Premier (where offered – in standard on Saturday, in JWW on Sunday), **then** Excellent/Master, Open, and Novice.

### Site Information

These Agility Trials will be held indoors on dirt. The Standard ring is 80' x120'; the JWW ring is 90' x 110'. The rings will be fenced with a combination of wood panels and portable fencing, with gates on the ends facing the center alley. Restroom facilities are on site. Crating will be indoors on concrete. Of course, we know everyone will uphold the **great reputation of agility exhibitors** by cleaning up after your dogs!

### Equipment

Obstacles used will meet the specifications given in the current AKC regulations. Contact obstacles have rubberized surfaces. Electronic timers will be used.

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place in each height division in each Regular and each Preferred class. Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. New Title rosettes will be available for those completing a new title.

A Rosette and jump bar will be awarded to any dog completing a MACH or PACH at either of these trials. A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show; none will be mailed.

\*\*\* If you think that you may complete a MACH or PACH at these trials, please let the trial secretary know ahead of time, so that we can plan to celebrate with you! \*\*\*

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above on this entry form.
