CORONAVIRUS INFO - UPDATED March 19, 2021

We are trying to make the best show possible given the current COVID situation. The State of WA issued new guidelines March 19. The situation continues to be fluid, so the procedures listed in this premium may change.

All participants will be required to adhere to the procedures detailed on page 2.

If you feel that you cannot adhere to these restrictions, are sick, have been exposed to COVID-19, or have other reasons not to be around crowds – please stay home!

Old Dog Benefit Runs

PSLRA is planning a non-standard run on Saturday to benefit Old Dog Haven. Proceeds from these runs will directly benefit Old Dog Haven, and the runs are a great way to celebrate all those dogs that helped make the sport what it is today! Old Dog Haven (https://olddoghaven.org) is a North End organization dedicated to helping Western Washington's homeless senior dogs.

An entry form is included later in this premium. We will be running a novice Jumpers course at either 4 or 8".

Dogs running in the Benefit can't be entered in the regular show, must be over 10 years old or otherwise considered "senior" for their breed. You must sign up in advance and by the closing date.

Agility Trial Covid Information

We are working to be compliant with AKC, CDC, State and County Health guidelines. Current guidelines were issued on March 19, 2021 for Agricultural Events (including dog shows).

General Info

Masks - Cloth masks are required in all indoor areas in WA state. That includes while running your dog.

Who is allowed indoors? – At this time only exhibitors, a videographer, and staff are allowed in the building. No spectators, guests, vendors, etc. are allowed.

Food - The club will not be offering any food to exhibitors. Please plan on bringing your own provisions.

Crating / Chairs – There is no exhibitor crating indoors. No chairs allowed except for ring crew.

Washing, disinfectants, PPE – Hand washing is critical. Hand sanitizer and limited PPE will be available from the club, but please plan on bring your own.

Bathrooms - Disinfecting spray will be in the porta-potties and restrooms for seats and door handles. It will be your responsibility to sanitize upon entering and leaving these locations.

Trial Specific Modifications

Gate Check-in/Steward – We will still have the normal paper gate check-in as well as an electronic system available via internet at r2agility.net if you have cellular service. If you do NOT have cell service, a local Wi-Fi system is provided (no internet) to allow check-in, status monitoring, run order, course maps, and scores. More details for both systems will be sent to you and onsite.

Briefings by Judge and Trial Chair - We will have limited briefings. Please keep you distance while at briefings.

Handlers waiting for their turn – Restrictions for people in the building have eased. If you are waiting your turn, please keep 6' distance. If you are simply watching or videoing be aware of others and keep your distance.

Walk-Throughs – Current state guidance is to keep groups of people 6' apart when possible and to limit their congregation to less than 15 minutes at a time. We will split walkthrus as needed to keep the number of people in the ring so that distancing is maintained.

Workers - The Chief Ring Steward will have the white boards set up outside near the entrance doors. There will be sanitizer available at the scribe table and elsewhere in the arena. Gloves are available if needed.

Results/Stickers/Ribbons - Results will be posted on wall boards by class instead of in binders. Stickers will be printed and pre-cut, so you will only pick up your own. Ribbons will be laid out on the table. Ribbon stickers will be by handler last name in boxes.

Waivers and COVID check-in

Waiver –The Club, R2Agility, facility, their owners, operators, members, and volunteers are working very hard to make this event the most compliant event possible. However, activities like dog shows are potentially dangerous given the current COVID pandemic. A specific waiver will need to be signed holding the above entities harmless in the event somebody gets sick at the event. This is in addition to the waiver on the AKC entry form.

The waiver is currently in PDF form that can be printed and brought to the show. We are working on an online waiver system that may be available by show time. We will send a reminder email to you a couple of days before the show about the waiver.

COVID Check-in – WA state guidance for customers has changed. We are NOT anticipating having a daily COVID screening with temperature checks. Instead, a pre-show checklist may be included with the waiver to ask the general COVID questions. At this time, we do not know if wristbands will be required. If they are, we will have a check-in table to verify receipt of the waiver and checklist before distributing the wristband.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRY INFORMATION: One entry form may be used for all days

Entry Fee: \$19.00 for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd runs and \$12.00 for the 4th, 5th, and 6th entry per dog, per day. These include

the required AKC fees of \$3.50 for the 1st, and \$3.00 for each subsequent run per dog/day.

ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

"PSLRA is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline (www.r2agilityonline.com) system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 220, Paper entries: 440. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly."

Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

1) include postage or be metered;

2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries

are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required"

AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded for qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

One toy (less than \$2 value) will be given to each dog entered.

First Place: Blue Second Place: Red Third Place: Yellow Fourth Place: White Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

A MACH/PAX Ribbon and a special BAR will be given for any new MACH/PAX dog! Let us know if you are close!

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted to the Trial Secretary in writing by

6:00 PM PDT on Monday, June 21, 2021. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send via mail, or email to robin@r2agilityonline.com. No phone move ups accepted. Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted at the trial. Move-ups must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial ends.

<u>REFUNDS:</u> A refund of entry fees, less \$5/run, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first class.

<u>DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:</u> This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISION

The following lists the required jump height for Preferred, and minimum height for regular agility classes. Judges only reserve the right to measure dogs at the trial that do not possess an official height card.

<u>OBSTACLES:</u> Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. <u>All Days</u> there will be **No Novice Contact Equipment Familiarization.**

<u>CLASSES OFFERED</u>: See the chart above for offered classes each day. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(s).

<u>PREFERRED CLASS INFORMATION</u>: You may not enter the same dog in preferred and regular classes in the same set of shows (weekend).

JUMP HEIGHT INFORMATION: Please indicate if your dog needs to be measured on the entry form.

Check your entry forms and confirmations:

Please be aware that AKC rules prohibit modification of an entry after the closing date/time. The ONLY allowed changes are for "move-ups" in class and those are required in writing by 6PM of the Monday before the trial. The trial secretary is not allowed to change jump heights, preferred vs. regular, or move down in classes after closing.

A preliminary email confirmation will be sent when the entry is received and processed. Make sure to check those confirmations closely and notify the trial secretary if you have corrections or changes before the closing date.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level
 entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes
 are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - o Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. We will NOT wait for exhibitors, except for pre-arranged changes due to conflict. Entry Confirmations and approximate check-in times will be sent to the address or <a href="mailto:emailto

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC form, or photocopies of AKC forms, without the agreement attached are not acceptable.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Puget Sound Labrador Retriever Association** assume **No** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund or any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

RING and CRATING INFORMATION: Crating space inside the arena is at a premium. There is crating in the stalls in the arena. You will be expected to share stalls with other exhibitors and their dogs. Stall doors must be left open at all times.

<u>Food Information:</u> There are fast food locations and grocery stores in Mt. Vernon within a few miles of the show site. The club will provide lunch for workers. There will not be a general lunch available for non-workers, so please plan accordingly.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height** division for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
