As of 8/10, the state of WA is allowing shows like ours with mandatory restrictions. SAFETY is our goal and fun can still be held by all.

All participants will be required to adhere to these main items (more details pg 2)

- Cloth Masks mandatory indoors at all times even when running.
- Masks required outdoors when not socially distant.
- No Crating allowed indoors & No spectators, visitors, family, friends allowed.
- Only participants and crew allowed indoors, and someone to record your run, are allowed in the arena while running or walking course.
- Dedicated "flow" of people thru building. Dedicated entrance/exit doors.
- A COVID waiver will be required when you arrive (covers club, crew, facility)
- A set of COVID questions and possibly a temp check will be done each morning.

If you feel that you cannot adhere to these restrictions, are sick, have been exposed to COVID-19, or have other reasons not to be around crowds – please stay home!

COVID PROCEDURES AND PRECAUTIONS:

We are working to be compliant with AKC, CDC, State and County Health guidelines. All guidelines may change as we get closer to the event time. These procedures and precautions will override related information in the rest of the premium.

Masks – Cloth masks are required in all indoor areas in WA state. That includes while running your dog. This is a state mandate and one we are required to follow. The exits from the building are close to the rings and we will try and provide an area outside the doors for you to remove your masks to regain your breath. PLEASE PUT YOUR MASK BACK ON BEFORE ANOTHER TEAM COMES AND BEFORE LEAVING THIS AREA

Food – The club **will not be** offering any food or beverages. Please bring your own. There will be no evening pot-lucks and unfortunately, no MACH/PACH cakes. Please plan accordingly.

Crating – There will be no crating in the building. We are required to minimize the number of people in the building and ensure those that are in the building are distanced. Crating out of your vehicle will be encouraged. You are also welcome to bring shade tents and there will be a designated location (to be determined). Parking spots close to the entrance and exit doors will be reserved for those crating from vehicles. The "in" doors and "out" doors will be identified during the briefing. Please honor any door signs.

Washing, disinfectants, PPE – Hand washing is critical. We are working to expand those facilities. Hand sanitizer and other limited PPE will be available from the club, but please plan on bringing your own.

Bathrooms – Disinfecting spray will be in the restrooms and porta-potties for seats and door handles. It will be your responsibility to sanitize upon entering and leaving these locations.

Trial Specific Modifications:

Gate Check-in/Steward – One person will be doing check-in. Class run order will be made available <u>ONLINE</u> for handlers, by class, so people don't have to keep looking at the board. Daily run orders will also be posted in locations outside. This will force us to limit moving of dogs after the running order is printed and posted. This may mean that we'll have to wait for people with multiple dogs. We'll NOT be using an electronic gate checkin/results system. Your running order will have more details.

Briefings by Judge and Trial Chair – We will have limited briefings. We must have very few people in the building at any given time. We will do our best to communicate (postings, website, texting, etc) so please bear with us.

Handlers waiting for their turn – Six foot markings (yet to be determined) will be created and Handlers/dogs will be expected to play musical markings until their turn in the ring. Then, they will proceed to the entry gate as instructed by the Gate Steward. Handlers must wear masks whenever in the arena, including while running.

Walk-Throughs – Walk-throughs will be managed by the number of handlers in a height class and announced at the briefings. Open and Novice will each walk their own class. FAST & T2B, and PREMIER **may** be split and Exc/Master will be split. Details will be in your information package after closing. This will enable walk-throughs to be smaller. We must keep each ring to a specific number, so there may be several walk-throughs for Ex/Masters. **NOTE:** In order to minimize changes, We MAY use the same schedule/Walk-throughs for the whole weekend.

Workers - Masks and gloves should be worn for all positions while in the ring.

The Chief Ring Steward and/or Trial Chair will have the white boards set up outside near the entrance doors. Write your name on these white boards if you are able to work. Please try and remember to remove your name if you are unable to perform the duties you signed up for.

The scoring table, leash runner, and bar setters should disinfect the chairs upon completion of their class. You are welcome to disinfect before as well. There will be disinfectant at the scribe/timer table. The timer will be located at a distance from the scribe. There will be a grabber for the leash runner to use and gloves for the bar setters.

Results/Stickers/Ribbons – Results will be posted on walls by class instead of in the binders. Stickers will be printed and pre- cut so you will only pick up your own. There will be a safe way to receive these. Ribbons will be laid out on the table. There may be a designated person to distribute the stickers and ribbons, please be patient.

Waivers and COVID check-in:

Waiver – The CDTA, Fun Fur Paws and Marian Snapp TS, their owners, operators, members, and volunteers are working hard to make this event the most compliant event possible. However, activities like dog shows are potentially dangerous given the current COVID pandemic. A specific waiver will need to be signed, holding the above entities harmless in the event somebody gets sick at the event. This is in addition to the waiver on the AKC entry form.

COVID Check-in – To help meet the WA state guidelines for this event, each participant will need to answer a brief set of questions and may have a non-contact temperature check. Do you have any COVID symptoms? Have you been in contact with a person with COVID? Have you tested positive for COVID in the last 14 days? Have you traveled outside the State of WA in the past 14 days? You will receive a COVID sticker EACH DAY that must be worn at all times and must be visible at all times.

These include required AKC fees (\$3.50 for first run & \$3 for each subsequent run). One entry form per dog may be used for all days.

CLOSING DATE: Friday, May 7th, 2021 at 11:30 p.m., at the Trial Secretary's home, *after which time entries cannot be accepted,* cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show rules. Confirmations will be sent by e-mail unless no e-mail is submitted or other form of delivery is requested.

ONLINE VS. PAPER ENTRY PRIMARY LIMITS

"CDTA" is accepting online entries through the R2AgilityOnline system. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Paper 350, Online 350. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly." Paper entries received within 24 hrs. of the opening date & time must:

1) include postage or be metered;

2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.

3) be designated **"no signature required"** if sent Express mail.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to any dog fifteen (15) months of age or older that is registered with the AKC or that has AKC Limited Registration, PAL/ILP, or an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Approved FSS breeds are also eligible to participate. Dogs with a PAL/ILP or a Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Enter online through **R2Agilityonline.com**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

REFUNDS: A complete refund will be given, for any reason, if withdrawal notice is received <u>before</u> the closing date and time. After closing, a refund of entry fees, less \$10/day, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification from a veterinarian is provided to the Trial Secretary before its first scheduled run of the weekend. A refund of <u>one-half</u> the entry fees will be given for dogs that are injured, provided a veterinary certificate is provided AND notification is received by the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes before the dog is scheduled to run in its first run of the weekend. Full refunds will be given in case of a judge change though only for the run(s) that are affected by the change. No other refunds will be given after closing. No refunds will be given for amounts less than \$10.00.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS

Confirmation of entry will be sent after it is received and processed. CHECK this for any errors and notify the trial secretary if there are any errors BEFORE the closing date. *PLEASE be aware that NO modifications to an entry may be made after the trial closes according to AKC regulations, other than move-ups that must be received in writing by 6 p.m. of the Monday before the trial.* This includes changes like Regular vs Preferred, Jump heights, or move down in classes.

OBSTACLES AND RING SIZE

All obstacles shall meet the specifications as outlined in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials. These agility trials will be held indoors in a heated arena on groomed dirt surface with the **STD/PREM ring larger than the JWW/T2B/FAST ring**. There will be no crating in the arena. *There will be no Novice equipment familiarization at these trials*.

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter the dog in the correct class. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for moveups as noted) after the closing date of the trial. <u>Be sure to check your entry form and confirmation letter carefully</u> and make certain you have entered the correct <u>classes and levels</u>. NOTE: Do NOT enter a class "higher" than you are eligible for on the assumption you will complete a title before this trial. "Move-downs" after the closing date for entries are not allowed. If this is your first entry in Preferred class you must start in the Novice class, or if you have not yet used your one-time lateral transfer the dog may enter in the same level as it runs in the regular classes but must jump 4" lower. A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC website at <u>www.akc.org</u>.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020. Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day.

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Class Changes Made Permanent, Effective January 1, 2021

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2021, For Exhibition Only has become a permanent part of the AKC Agility program and may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - o Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - \circ \quad Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On (FNG) allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note.

Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Height Divisions

As of March 1, 2021, if a VMO or Agility Field Representative is measuring dogs at a trial, all present and entered dogs without a valid measurement must be measured. Measuring will begin ½ hour before the first dog runs on all three days and may occur between classes depending upon judge availability.

HEIGHT CARD REGULATIONS

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to mark if your dog needs to be measured. This lets the Trial Secretary know whether to include your dog on the "Dogs to Be Measured List". It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

There are also Double Q ribbons for dogs running at Masters Level. Please ask for yours! Please notify the Trial Chair or Trial Secretary if you have the potential of completing a MACH, or PACH title at this trial 🙂.

MOVE-UPS – CHECK-IN

Deadline for move-ups for these trials is Monday, May 10th 2021 at 6 p.m. PDT. Move-ups must be submitted in writing (e- mail okay). Move-ups are not official until e-mail confirmation of the move-up has been received by the participant. Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday move-ups will be allowed.

There will be no formal check-in. A run order will be available at the ribbon table and online at Scores4K9sNW.com. PLEASE remember to check in directly on the Gate Sheet or with the Gate Steward before your runs. No ELECTRONIC check in will be used.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

HOSPITALITY INFORMATION

At this point, there will be no food or beverage provisions made for competitors. Please bring your own food and drink. Sadly, no MACH or PACH cakes are allowed for sharing.

VOLUNTEERS

We'll be using the White Board for all positions. If you want to do something special, please let us know and we'll sign you up ahead of time. Also, if you want to learn a job, just ask the chief ring steward who can put you with someone who will show you the ropes.

Volunteer draws for prizes and future entries will be made in the afternoons on each day of the trial. Thanks for your help!

- The Trial will be open each day from 7:30 to 5:30 p.m. Consult the Final Information/Run Order for order of classes and times of judging.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, faxed, or telegraphed entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms and/or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules that accompany the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable. Entry fees must accompany entries for it to be valid.
- Postdated checks do not constitute a valid entry. Checks will be deposited immediately after the trial closes. Competitors whose check is returned will be assessed an additional fee equal to the amount charged to the club for the returned check.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Entry fees will NOT be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge during the trial, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. (Exceptions to Refunds are stated on page 2)
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or child(ren) create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Sorry, no puppies under 3 months of age are allowed in the trial arena. Aggressive dogs will not be allowed.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds. Head halters and body harnesses are OK.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area or off leash areas. The leash may have a single pick-up bag and/or identification tag attached to it. Painted or stitched designs or information on collars can be only the dog's name and/or identifying information.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. We will NOT wait for exhibitors. Judging will begin no earlier than 8:30 AM.
- The Chuckanut Dog Training Association, Inc., Fun Fur Paws, LLC., and Marian Snapp, assume NO responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardian.
- CRATING There will be no crating in the building. Please crate from your car or from a sheltered area of your own. Areas for canopies/pop-ups will be designated on the site map included with the Run Order information sent after closing.
- PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG(S). Failure to do so will be considered a benchable offense and we REALLY want to use this facility in the future.
- THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.
