Entry Fees

First entry is \$20.00 per day; additional entries of same dog, same day are \$15.00. Entry fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 for each entry.

ONLINE ENTRIES: Online entries are available for these trials through R2 Agility, https://www.r2agilityonline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be 100 runs/trial via online entries, 230 runs/trial via paper entries. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly. The club is not maintaining a wait list for online entries.

REFUNDS: A full refund of entry fees will be given for any reason if a written (or email) request is received by the Trial Secretary <u>before</u> closing. After closing, a full refund of entry fees will be given for a bitch that comes into season, if written (or email) notification is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate, provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Please designate the dog's breed as "All American" on the entry form.

Important Information for Exhibitors -- PLEASE READ!

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, fax, e-mail or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form, are not acceptable. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, regardless of who makes such errors. The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes (except for move-ups as a result of completing a title, and correction of specific errors as provided in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 21) after the closing date of the trial. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es). Contact the Trial Secretary if you have questions!

Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the delivery signature requirement waived; otherwise receipt may be delayed. Entries will not be considered as being received until they are delivered to the address given on the entry form. Please note the opening date of April 16, 2025; no entries will be accepted before that date. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in one envelope; envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be considered invalid, and will be returned to the sender. No hand delivered entries can be accepted until 9:00 AM on April 17, 2025.

PHDF is using a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries (runs) will be placed on each trial's wait list. All entries must have been received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing on Friday, May 30, 2025 at 9:00 PM. Any entries withdrawn, with notification to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail is OK) by 6:00 PM on Monday, June 9, 2025 will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry; otherwise no refund will be given for withdrawn entries, except as specified above. Any wait listed entry that does not get into the trial will receive a full refund.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent (other than bitches in season as specified), disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

Confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be e-mailed (or sent by postal mail to the address on the official AKC entry form, if no e-mail is provided) after the closing date; if not received at least 7 days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a valid e-mail address on the entry form, or includes a stamped, self-addressed postcard or envelope with entry.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

The Palouse Hills Dog Fanciers and the Trial Secretary assume NO responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site and no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Dale Mahoney is not a VMO. Dogs that do not have ANY official measurements, or whose temporary measurement has expired, WILL need to be measured at these trials by the judge of record. Dogs with an unexpired (still under 2 years of age) OFFICIAL temporary measurement or at least one OFFICIAL permanent measurement will NOT need to be measured; you must use that measurement to determine your dog's jump height. If your dog has never been measured, please provide a (reasonable) estimate of your dog's height at the withers.

Move-Up Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the handler, as a result of completing an agility title at an earlier event, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing (e-mail is acceptable), by 6:00 PM on **Monday, June 9, 2025.** If a dog finishes a title during the trial, the handler may move up for the following days by filling out a move-up form (available at the event) and turning it in to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the end of judging for the day.

Site Information

These Agility Trials will be held outdoors on grass, ring size 120' by 120'. Rings are on the eastern side of the fairgrounds - no tree roots! The rings will be fenced, with entry/exit openings. Water and portable toilets are on site. Please be prepared to provide shade for your dogs. And of course, we know you will uphold the great reputation of agility exhibitors by cleaning up after your dogs!

On Friday, the grounds will open for exhibitor setups starting at 10:00 AM. The club will be setting up the rings earlier in the morning, so please do not attempt to set up before that time. PLEASE NOTE: To protect the grass, MATTING is required under all crates and ex-pens.

Volunteer Workers

As you probably know, there are quite a variety of tasks that go along with holding an agility trial, and we greatly appreciate volunteers to help share the work load. We will have a white board for worker sign-up at the trials. We will have some individually wrapped snacks for workers, and a "better than ever" workers raffle!

Equipment

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Equipment is provided by Jim and Laurie Clark. All contact obstacles and tables will have rubberized surfaces.

Awards

All awards are courtesy of Palouse Hills Dog Fanciers. A qualifying score is required for all awards, and no awards will be mailed. Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place in each height division in each Regular and each Preferred class. Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores.

Each day of the trial, PHDF offers "High in Class" awards for each Novice, Open, Excellent, and Master Standard and JWW class in the Regular and Preferred divisions. The highest qualifying score over all jump heights within each class, with ties broken by the fastest yards per second, will be awarded a rosette and a certificate for \$10.00 in entry fees to a PHDF AKC agility trial in 2026.

All dogs earning a MACH or PACH title at these trials will receive a MACH or PACH bar and rosette. If you are close to earning an award, please let the Trial Chair know ahead of time, so that we are prepared to celebrate with you!

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights [in different classes] within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. [EXAMPLE: if you are entering a dog in some Regular classes and some Preferred classes, submit one entry form for the Regular classes, and another entry form for the Preferred classes.]

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. <u>FEO is allowed in all classes</u>. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class.
 FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. <u>If entered in an ineligible jump height</u>, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. <u>Day of show jump height changes are not allowed</u>.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent,
 Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed
 <u>to FEO for that run</u> and must declare FEO on the start line. <u>Day of show</u>
 level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - o Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

From the south: From HWY 95 N, turn RIGHT onto HWY 8 East (second light in Moscow). Go 1 mile to light at Eastside Marketplace Mall and turn LEFT onto Blaine St. Go one block, turn RIGHT on White Ave. Fairgrounds entrance is first road on LEFT.

From the north: Take HWY 95 S into Moscow (becomes one-way Jackson St.). At south end of town, street bends left (east). In left lane, go through light onto HWY 8 East. Go 1 mile to light at Eastside Marketplace Mall and turn LEFT onto Blaine St. Go one block, turn RIGHT on White Ave. Fairgrounds entrance is first road on LEFT.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
