Entry Fees

First entry is \$20.00 per day; additional entries of the same dog on the same day are \$15.00. Junior Handlers receive a \$5.00 discount for each class entered. Entry fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per entry.

A full refund of entry fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season, and a refund of entry fees, less \$5.00 per run, will be given for any dog or handler that is injured or ill, if written notification is provided to the Trial Secretary prior to the beginning of judging for the day. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds.

Online Entries

Online entries are available for these trials through R2 Agility, https://www.r2agilityonline.com/ During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be as follows:

Friday trial, 75 runs via online entries, 175 runs via paper entries.

Saturday trial, 100 runs via online entries, 250 runs via paper entries.

Sunday trial, 100 runs via online entries, 250 runs via paper entries.

If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

The club is not maintaining a wait list for online entries.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate, provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Please designate the dog's breed as "All American" on the entry form.

Important Information for Exhibitors -- PLEASE READ!

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, fax, e-mail or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form, are not acceptable. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after closing, EXCEPT as provided for in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 21. Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es). Contact the Trial Secretary if you have guestions!

Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the delivery signature requirement waived; otherwise receipt may be delayed. Entries will not be considered as being received until they are delivered to the address given on the entry form. Please note the opening date of March 24, 2025; no entries will be accepted before that date. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in one envelope; envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be considered invalid, and will be returned to the sender. No hand delivered entries can be accepted until 8:00 AM on March 25, 2025.

SDTC is using a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries (runs) will be placed on each trial's wait list. All entries must have been received by the Trial Secretary prior to Friday, April 25, 2025 at 8:00 PM. Any entries withdrawn, with notification to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail is OK) by 8:00 PM on Monday, May 5, 2025 will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry; otherwise no refund will be given for withdrawn entries, except as specified above. Any wait listed entry that does not get into the trial will receive a full refund.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent (other than as specified on page 2). disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

Confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be e-mailed (or sent by postal mail to the address on the official AKC entry form, if no e-mail is provided) after the closing date; if not received at least 7 days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a valid e-mail address on the entry form, or includes a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Security personnel will be present at the trial site overnight. However, Spokane Dog Training Club, Inc. assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site and no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Our judge, Karen Wlodarski, is a VMO (Voluntary Measuring Official). Dogs at least 2 years old that have not completed the two (or three if a tie-breaker is needed) official measurements for a permanent height card WILL need to be measured at these trials by the judge. Dogs under 2 years old that have not had an official temporary measurement will also need to be measured.

Move-Up Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the handler, as a result of completing an agility title at an earlier event, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, in writing (e-mail is acceptable), by 6:00 PM on **Monday, May 5, 2025**. If a dog finishes a title during the trial, the handler may move up for the following days by filling out a move-up form and turning it in to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the end of judging for the day.

Equipment

Obstacles will meet the specifications in the Regulations for Agility trials. Contact obstacles and tables have rubberized surfaces. Tunnels are 26" diameter. Jumps are vinyl, with plastic jump cup strips.

Volunteer Workers

As you probably know, there are quite a variety of tasks that go along with holding an agility trial, and we greatly appreciate volunteers to help share the work load. We will have a white board for worker sign-up at the trials. You will get a coupon usable toward future SDTC agility entries for each class that you work.

Judging

Judging starts <u>no earlier than NOON</u> on Friday, 8:00 a.m. on both Saturday and Sunday. Judges' briefing and first course walk-through will be scheduled prior to that time.

** NEW Parking Information (PLEASE READ - CHANGED FROM LAST YEAR!) **

GOOD NEWS! The area of Sontag Park that includes the ring and the grass parking area has been transferred to the school and is no longer State Parks property, so you do NOT need a Discover Pass to park on the grass this year! The not-as-good news is that the school has added more recess/lunch times when children are outdoors, and is requiring that NO vehicles can be driven into or out of the grassy area between the hours of 8:45 AM and 3:30 PM on Friday. If you drive in before 8:45 AM, your vehicle must stay parked until 3:30 PM. After 3:30 PM Friday, and on Saturday and Sunday, there are no time restrictions.

If you park in the semicircle drive by the shelter you MUST display a valid Discover Pass on your vehicle. There is a \$99 fine for not having a valid pass on a vehicle on park property.

Nine Mile Falls Elementary School is generously allowing participants to park on school grounds behind the gym, and in <u>designated</u> parts of their parking lot, on Friday. On Saturday and Sunday, their entire parking lot is available for exhibitor parking. We will send out a map of parking areas along with other exhibitor information after closing.

Site Information

These Agility Trials will be held outdoors on grass, ring size 100' by 100'. The ring will be fenced, with entry/exit openings. Water and portable toilets are on site. There is some shade, but please be prepared to provide shade for your dogs. And of course, we know you will uphold the great reputation of agility exhibitors by cleaning up after your dogs. The trial site is adjacent to the Centennial trail, which provides opportunities for hiking and cycling.

Directions to Show

From either the east or west, take I-90 to the Maple Street Bridge exit (#280) and go north approximately 4 miles. [The one-way northbound street starts out as Walnut, then becomes Maple; Ash is one-way south.] Turn left (west) on Francis, which becomes Nine Mile Road (State Highway 291). Just after Nine Mile Falls (small store/gas station, post office), turn left (west) on Charles Road, which crosses the Spokane River at Nine Mile Dam. Sontag Park is on the right just after the bridge, and Nine Mile Falls Elementary School is just past the park.

Refreshments

Coffee, tea and water will be available as a courtesy for all exhibitors. We will not be providing lunch, so please bring your own or visit the Tin Cup Cafe across the road (not open on Sunday).

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights [in different classes] within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. [EXAMPLE: if you are entering a dog in some Regular classes and some Preferred classes, submit one entry form for the Regular classes, and another entry form for the Preferred classes.] When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is now allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class.
 FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an
 ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must
 declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not
 allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of a class (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and judge.
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place in each height division in each Regular and each Preferred class. Green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores.

On Saturday only, a rosette will be awarded to the highest scoring **Novice A** dog based on the dog's combined score/time in Novice A standard + Novice A JWW. Dogs must receive a qualifying score in both classes.

Any exhibitor whose dog completes a title at these trials will receive a New Title ribbon, or may choose a title pin instead of a ribbon if available (we are phasing them out). A Rosette and jump bar will be awarded to any dog completing a MACH or PACH at these trials. A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show; none will be mailed.

*** If you think that you may complete a MACH or PACH at these trials, please let the trial secretary know ahead of time, so that we can plan to celebrate with you! ***

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes must compete at the required jump height and may **not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eliqible to enter all-breed AKC aqility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
